

# PBL IN THE ARTS ONLINE COURSE

Project Based Learning places the emphasis on how we come to know something, and less on what we know. PBL is a shift away from teaching to the test and while it is rooted in standards, it is process and inquiry based. PBL employs creative processes like the design process, which naturally aligns to creative processes used in the arts. The arts are project-based by their very nature, and encourage skills that have been identified as those essential for students to be college and career ready: creativity, collaboration, communication, and critical thinking.

In this course, students investigate and apply the intersections of project based learning and the arts for a deeply engaging classroom experience that is focused on the process and provides opportunities for students to make real-world connections.
